Promotion Criteria

Classes VI, VII, VIII & IX

- Students securing E grade (less than 33%) in individual subjects in the total weightage of promotional calculation will have to appear for Retest.
- Retest dates for classes VI, VII and IX will be informed by the school. The Retest schedule for class VIII will be notified by DAVCMC.

Classes XI & XII

- Students who have secured 33% in individual subjects (separately in theory & practical) will be promoted to class XII
- Those who fail in more than two main subjects will be detained.
- Those who fail in one main subject will be promoted to class XII considering the marks secured in sixth optional (if passed)
- Those who fail in two main subjects would appear for compartmental examination. In case they fail to secure pass marks in the failed subjects, they will be detained.
